


OUR SCHOOL

ADMISSION

Admission is open to all students, with no prejudice to caste, religion, region or gender. Ordinarilly students are admitted only at the beginning of the school year. New pupils must be personally introduced by their parents or guardians who will be responsible to the school authorities for their conduct, regularity of attendance, devotion to studies, and timely payment of fees.

Registration/Admission form must be duly filled and signed by the parents/guardians. The form should be accompanied by original and/or xerox copy of the authentic documents as mentioned in the form.

Admission to Nursery is done after verifying the preliminary documents. Admission to other classes depends on the number of seats available in those classes.

The name and date of birth once entered in the admission register cannot be altered. A recent passport size photo of the candidate has to be attached on the application form.

A student of this school after UKG and Class X Board Examination must formally be admitted to the next class. Students with a track record of bad conduct, irregular attendance, careless attitude towards studies and poor percentage of marks may be denied admission to the next class. The decision of the Principal in this regard is final.



OUR STAFF

The quality of an institution depends on the quality and dedication of its staff and the management. Our Teachers are well qualified, highly motivated and deeply committed to the cause of education. Code of Conduct for Students

The school expects all the students to maintain a high standard of discipline. Students must be regular and punctual at school. Students are expected to communicate only in English, which is the medium of instruction. They should be dedicated to academics and participate in co-scholastic and extra curricular activities of the school. They should be well mannered, courteous and considerate to the needs of others. Students must respect the authorities and staff members of the school. They must follow all the rules and regulations prescribed by the school. Any failure on the part of the students to abide by the rules and regulations will attract appropriate punishment.





























TO PARENTS

- 1. Parents are expected to co-operate with the school authorities by enforcing regularity and discipline in their children. They have to prepare a time table for home study and supervise their assignment. They may help them in preparing their daily lessons.
- 2. Students who fail to show these remarks and reports and get them countersigned by their parents are liable to punished and sent home.
- 3. Parents, guardians or other persons are never allowed to meet the students or teachers during class hours at the door of class rooms. On emergencies they may contact the Principal, in the office. ■



RULES FOR BUS SERVICE

- The school provides with an optional bus service. The bus fee should be paid along with the tuition fee for months. The fee is charged according to the distance.

 One side fare is not treated.
- 2 Students misbehaving in the bus and the defaulter of fee will not be allowed to continue the use of the bus service. The school bus is directly under the control of the Principal. Any suggestion or complaints may be made only to the Principal and not to the bus staff.
- Reasonable care is taken by the school authorities for the safety of the children in the school premises and in the school bus.
- The bus service must be hired for full academic year i.e. June to April. No cancellation will be allowed under any circumstances during the year.
- 5 Students will be responsible for any damage window glass panes, seats etc. of the bus damage will be recovered from the students.
